Barrington River Organic Farm is nestled in the pristine foothills of the Barrington Ranges, NSW, three hours north of Sydney. Our farm is 250 acres of lush pasture and fertile soil beside the Barrington River. Along with our Devon cattle, we grow award-winning garlic, turmeric, black walnut trees, and olive trees.

In 2002 we purchased a small herd of organic Devons from Paterson in the Hunter Valley. In a good year we can run up to 70 head; in a dry year we can carry 40 cows and heifers with calves at foot. We have a "closed herd" policy using our own bred bull and buying in a bull to extend the blood lines when necessary. We recently purchased a bull at auction from Ashwood Devons at Bulahdelah. Two year old Bongalabi Kosciusko (Kosi for short) has settled in well and is enjoying mingling with the herd.

We chose Devons because they are beautiful animals with a lovely, docile temperament and a strong mothering instinct. We have found Devons to be extremely efficient animals—they cope well in a variety of conditions and breed quickly and easily with a minimum of fuss or investment.

As our farm is Certified Biodynamic, our Devon cattle enjoy a superior lifestyle in a pristine, stress-free environment. This results in exceptional quality beef.
